TEACHER TAX DEDUCTIONS REALLY ADD UP. MAKE SURE YOU CLAIM ALL OF YOURS TO MAXIMISE YOUR REFUND THIS YEAR.

TOP TAX DEDUCTIONS FOR TEACHERS



PROFESSIONAL FEES AND EDUCATION:

- Union fees
- Teaching memberships and subscriptions
- Self-education expenses (must be related to your current role)

EXAMPLE: TEACHER UNION FEES OR A BLUE CARD APPLICATION FEE.





TRAVEL AND TRANSPORT EXPENSES

- Car travel (via logbook or cents/ km method)
- Costs for school excursions
- Overnight stays

EXAMPLE: YOU TRAVELLED, AT YOUR OWN EXPENSE, TO ANOTHER SCHOOL FOR A SPORTS CARNIVAL.



WORK PURCHASES:

- Teaching supplies (not provided by employer)
- Sun protection: sunglasses, hats, sunscreen
- Protective clothing

EXAMPLE: YOU PURCHASED TEACHING AIDS FOR YOUR CLASSROOM AND WERE NOT REIMBURSED BY YOUR EMPLOYER.



WORK FROM HOME EXPENSES:

- Home office running expenses
- Phone and internet costs
- Office equipment purchases (computers, desks etc.)

EXAMPLE: YOU WORKED FROM HOME 10 HOURS PER WEEK PLANNING LESSONS AND MARKING WORK.

SNAP YOUR RECEIPTS

Make sure you keep a record of all your receipts, even if you're not 100% sure you can claim it.



LOG IT ALL

Be sure to log all your work-related car trips and work from home hours. This way, you won't short-change yourself come tax time.



IF YOU'VE BEEN REIMBURSED YOU CAN'T CLAIM IT

If your employer has reimbursed you for an out-of-pocket expense related to your work, then you can't claim it on your tax return.
